PolioPlus, Rotary's most ambitious program to date, focuses on the global immunization effort to eradicate Polio.

Since we started the fight against polio, we've reduced the number of polio cases by 99.9 percent and reached more than 2.5 billion children with the vaccine. There are fewer polio cases today than ever before, but we will not stop until we reach zero.

If polio is not eradicated; hundreds of thousands of children could be paralyzed, global health care costs would rise dramatically, and the quality of life for many children would be drastically diminished.

We are now "This Close" to achieving a Polio-free world. The Rotary Club of Grass Valley has supported this historic effort since its inception and will continue this support until Polio is totally eradicated worldwide.
